St. Valentine: 14th February

Shrine of St. Valentine: In the heart of Dublin The Church of Our Lady of Mount Carmel & Shrine of Saint Valentine It is on November 10, 1836 that the Reliquary containing the remains of St. Valentine arrived in Dublin and were brought in solemn procession to Whitefriar Street Church where they were received by Archbishop Murray of Dublin. With the death of Fr Spratt interest in the relics died away and they went into storage. During a major renovation in the church in the 1950s/60s they were returned to prominence with an altar and shrine being constructed to house them and enable them to be venerated. Today, the Shrine is visited throughout the year by couples who come to pray to Valentine and to ask him to watch over them in their lives together.

February is the month when plants and flowers have a huge growth surge and compost really helps them get off to a good start. Spring-flowering bulbs are the earliest plants to bloom in the garden. Depending on the weather, cold-hardy snowdrops and winter aconites make an appearance in February or March. Crocuses soon follow, along with scillas and Chionodoxas. As spring arrives, daffodils and hyacinths emerge in March and April, followed by tulips and ornamental onions in May and early June.
