The annual Mass for those whose funerals were celebrated in the Church of Divine Mercy since November 2023 will be held on Tuesday Nov 19th at 7.30pm.

### Indulgences for the Holy Souls

1. From twelve o'clock noon on 1 November until midnight on 2 November, all who have confessed, received Holy Communion and prayed for the pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church or oratory, and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostle's Creed. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed.

Confession may be made at any time within the week preceding or the week following 1st November. Holy Communion may be received on any day from 1 November to 8 November.

2. A plenary indulgence may be gained, applicable only to the Holy Souls, on the usual conditions once per day from 1st to 8th November. The conditions mentioned above apply also for this.
